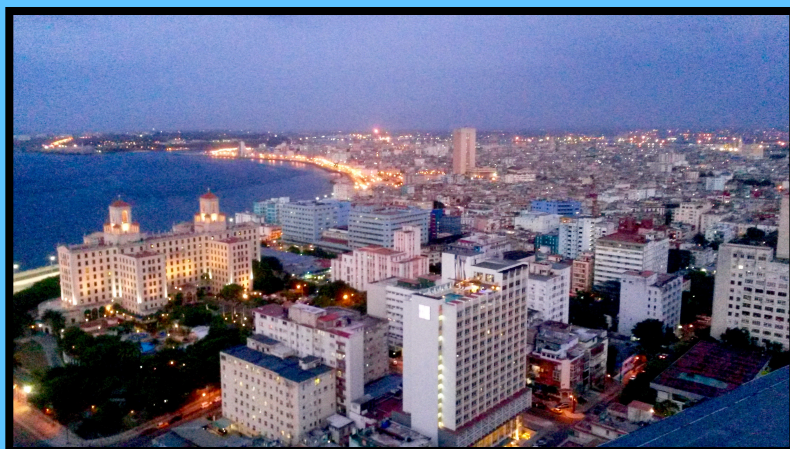
Study Abroad with the Autonomous University of Social Movements
