Zapatismo and the Sixth Declaration covers the practice, theory, and context of the Zapatista movement and its Sixth Declaration of the Lacandón Jungle. Students live at the Language School in Oventic, a powerful center of indigenous education, healthcare, cooperatives, and autonomous government. Program includes intensive conversational Spanish or Tsotsil (a Mayan language spoken widely in the highlands of Chiapas).
