**History, Culture, and Politics of Cuba** offers a constructively critical look at Cuba's ongoing socialist revolution. Students live with Cuban families in the Afro-Cuban barrio of Marianao in Havana. The program includes encounters with the country's vibrant music and arts scenes, engagement with Cuba's ecological agriculture and newly forming cooperatives, and a week-long trip to Cuba's central and eastern provinces.

**Zapatismo and the Sixth Declaration** covers the practice, theory, and context of the Zapatista movement and its Sixth Declaration of the Lacandón Jungle. Students live at the Language School in Oventic, a powerful center of indigenous education, healthcare, cooperatives, and autonomous government. Program includes intensive conversational Spanish or Tsotsil (a Mayan language spoken widely in the highlands of Chiapas).
